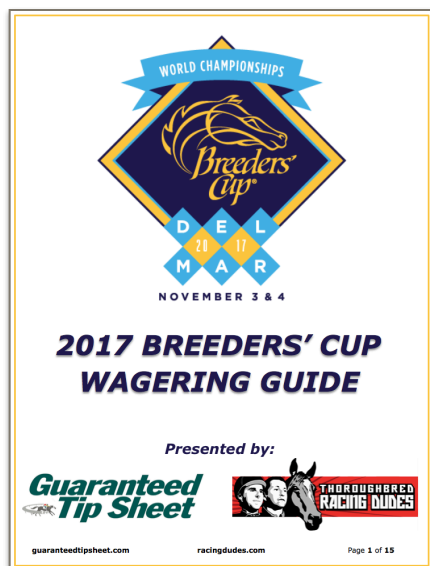

JUVENILE FILLIES TURF

Aidan O'Brien has never won the **Juvenile Fillies Turf** in its nine years of existence, while Chad Brown has won three overall and two of the last three.



DIRT MILE

The favorite has won the **Dirt Mile** only twice in the history of the race (10). However, it's certainly trending towards chalk, as the odds-on favorite has won twice in the last three years.



JUVENILE TURF

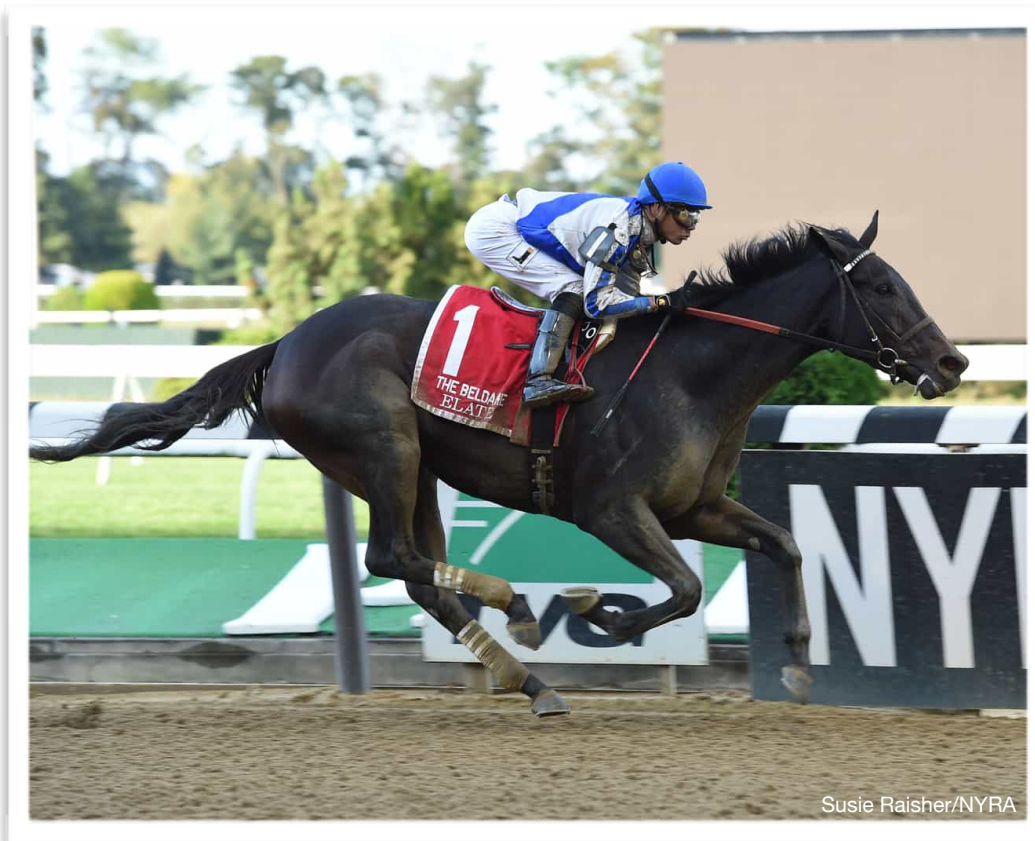
European-based horses have won the **Juvenile Turf** EIGHT times in the history of the race (10). However, US-based horses have won two of the last three.



DISTAFF

Bill Mott has won the **Breeders' Cup Distaff** five different times with four different horses (Royal Delta being the only one to win twice in back-to-back years in 2011/2012). Mott will saddle Elate in this year's running.

JUVENILE FILLIES

5

In three of the last four years, horses at 30-1 or higher have won the **Juvenile Fillies**. Songbird (a 3-5 favorite in 2015) is the only exception.



TURF SPRINT

6

The **Turf Sprint** will be run at a distance of 5 furlongs for the first time since 2011, when the favorite, Regally Ready, won that edition at Churchill Downs. Lady Aurelia figures to be a solid favorite this year.

FILLY & MARE SPRINT

Only two different horses have won the **Filly & Mare Sprint** as the odds-on favorite (Groupie Doll did it back-to-back in 2012 & 2013 with Judy the Beauty doing it the following year in 2014). Unique Bella, this year's likely favorite, will try to become the third.

FILLY & MARE TURF

8

European-based fillies have won the **Filly & Mare Turf** at a clip of nearly 40%. However, Chad Brown has won the race three of the last five years.



SPRINT

9

Horses tend to win the **Breeders' Cup Sprint** while stalking the pace but never sitting more than 2-5 lengths off of the leaders. The last five winners have done exactly that.



MILE

10

Five of the last six editions of the **Mile** were won by US-based horses. Surprisingly, the overall count favors US runners (19) vs. European horses (14).



JUVENILE

11

Historically, the **Breeders' Cup Juvenile** has produced fairly consistent results, with some of the best runners running well. In recent years, highly-regarded horses such as Classic Empire, Not This Time, Nyquist, Carpe Diem, Havana, Shanghai Bobby, Hansen, and Uncle Mo entered the race and ran well. Bolt d'Oro enters this year's edition as that horse.



TURF

12

European-based horses have won the **Turf** at a devastating clip of 64%, while Aidan O'Brien has won four of the last six years.



CLASSIC

13

Bob Baffert has won the **Breeders' Cup Classic** the last three years (Arrogate, American Pharoah, Bayern) and will look to make it four with Arrogate, Collected, Mubtaahij, and West Coast all likely starters this year.
